
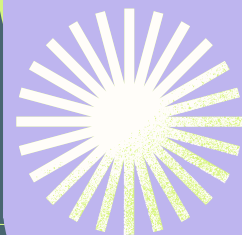

The 2025 Hemispherectomy Foundation Australia Family Conference (HemiCon) will be held at SeaWorld Resort on the Gold Coast, Queensland 16-17 May 2025. About HemiCon 2025

HemiCon is our biennial conference for children and their families effected by hemispherectomy brain surgery. A hemispherectomy is the complete disconnection or removal of one brain hemisphere to treat life-threatening epilepsy. After hemispherectomy, children experience permanent disability, including hemiplegias, visual loss and cognitive deficits. HemiCon is to be held in collaboration with Australian paediatric clinicians and the Pediatric Epilepsy Surgery Alliance (United States) and will provide a supportive and inclusive environment for children, young people and families to participate in conference sessions delivered by a range of clinical and other experts. Conference sessions address the physical, social and visual needs of hemispherectomy children and the emotional and psychological needs of their parents and caregivers.

About the Hemispherectomy Foundation Australia

The Hemispherectomy Foundation Australia is a registered Australian health promotion charity dedicated to supporting families impacted by hemispherectomy surgery.

Our goals are to:

- provide information, advice and support to families with children who have had hemispherectomy surgery or who may need a hemispherectomy in the future.
- raise awareness of hemispherectomy surgery, and the needs of hemispherectomy patients and their families.
- promote research aimed at improving the recovery and quality of life of hemispherectomy children and young people, and research on the neurological conditions that currently can be cured only by radical hemispherectomy surgery.
